WE pray that the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ will grant us according to the riches of His Glory to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in our heart by faith; that we being rooted and grounded in God's love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width, length, depth and height; and to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that we might be filled with all the fullness of God. (Ephesians 3: 14-19)

WE pray that our love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all discernment; that we may approve things that are excellent; that we may be sincere and without offense until the day of Christ; being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, to the Glory and praise of God. (Philippians 1: 9-11)

WE pray that we may be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that we may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened in all might, according to His Glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness; giving thanks unto the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light; Who has delivered

us from the power of darkness and has translated us into the Kingdom of His dear Son. In whom we have *redemption* through His blood, even the forgiveness of sin. (Colossians 1: 9-12)

WE pray that the communication of our faith becomes effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing, which is in us in Christ Jesus. (Philemon 1: 6)

WE pray that by the grace of God given unto us through Jesus Christ that we are enriched in everything by Christ, in all utterance and in all knowledge; even as the testimony of Christ is confirmed in us; so that we come behind in no gift, waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. (I Corinthians 1:4-7)

WE pray that God would count us worthy of His calling and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in us and we in Him according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Thessalonians 1: 11,12)

WE pray that we will stand perfect and complete in all the will of God. (Colossians 4:12)

WE pray that the God of peace, through the blood of the everlasting Covenant will make us perfect in every good work to do His will, working in us that which is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. (Hebrews 13:20,21)
